





Installation

Setting Glass into Shoes: Place 6" long pieces (152mm) of shoe insert (model #946) onto glass panel at three or more equidistant locations, then lower glass into the shoe. There is space between the glass and the inside shoe walls that should have filler inserted into it to plumb and set the glass properly. The choice of filler is at the discretion of the installer (use of epoxy based fillers is not recommended.) Add caulking as needed above the filler.





Mounting Handrail Brackets onto Glass: Order glass predrilled with 5/8" (16mm) holes in glass before tempering. (Warning: Drilling tempered glass is not recommended!) Insert plastic bushing in hole. Slip clear plastic gasket onto back plate stud and insert in hole. Place other clear plastic gasket onto the base of the bracket and thread bracket onto stud of back plate. Mounting Channel Tubing (Cap Rail) onto Glass: #926 Channel Tubing

Protective Insert sits on top edge of glass panel between glass and cap rail. Use of a clear adhesive windshield sealer is recommended.
