

Surface Mounted Napkin/Tampon Vendor



Specification

Surface Mounted Napkin/Tampon Vendor shall combine two dispensing mechanisms in one cabinet to provide sanitary napkins or tampons at user's choice. Unit shall be stainless steel type 304 (18-8) and shall hold 30 napkins and 27 tampons of specified sizes. Structural assembly of body and door components shall be of welded construction and have no exposed fasteners or welded seams. All exposed surfaces shall be satin finish and shall be protected during shipment with a PVC film easily removable after installation. Cabinet shall be fabricated of 22 gauge and door shall be 18 gauge (1.2mm), mounted with heavy-duty full-length 3/16" dia. stainless

Operation

Insert coin in napkin or tampon mechanism and turn handle to dispense boxed sanitary napkin or tampon tube. Indicator displays empty condition and blocks coin slot when product is depleted. Unit can be replenished by opening door and manually reloading product into dispenser supply tracks. Track weights **must** be used to provide positive feed.



Installation

- For maximum usability and compliance with ADA Accessibility Guidelines, unit should be installed so that coin slot is between 54" (1372mm) maximum above finished floor (AFF) and 38" (965mm) minimum AFF.
- 2. It is the installer's responsibility to select fasteners that

steel multi-staked piano hinge and shall be held closed with two (2) tumbler locks keyed like other TSM washroom accessories. Internal coin box shall be equipped with a tumbler lock keyed differently from dispenser door. Dispensing mechanisms shall be fastener mounted internally to provide ability to change mechanisms for coinage denomination. Factory installed coin operation denominations shall be 25¢. Coin mechanisms shall carry no brand-name advertising. Unit shall be equipped with weights for each feed track.

Surface Mounted Napkin/Tampon Vendor shall be Model 5100 as manufactured by Tubular Specialties Manufacturing, 13011 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, California 90061, tel 800-Grab Bar.

Napkin capacity is 30 singles that are cardboard-boxed with a semigloss finish; size is $4^{1}/4^{"} \times 3^{"} \times 1^{1}/8^{"}$. Brands: Stayfree #4; Guards #247 or 147; Kotex #704, 707, 07010, 07040, 07045, 07300, 07320; Pure-Nat #M-4; Modess #4.

Tampon capacity is 27 cylinders that are cardboard, semigloss with crimped ends; tube size is $^3/4^{\prime\prime}$ dia. x $5^1/4^{\prime\prime}.$ Brands: Tampax, Modess.
